ELIGIBILITY:

The Competition is at National Level i.e. limited to India, for the age group 18+ years.

DATE OF CONTEST:

3rd October to 31st October 2020.

RULES FOR PARTICIPATION:

- ◆ Each participant is allowed to submit only 1 poster.
- ◆ A3 size paper should be used for poster competition, with margins drawn with black pen/marker.
- ◆ The participants are free to choose any type of colours for drawing/painting which may include pencil, crayon, watercolor, oil paint, etc.
- ◆ The poster should be original and hand made work of the participant.
- ◆ **Name and Address of the participant must be clearly mentioned on the right-hand side bottom of the sheet.**
- ◆ **Each participant has to present about his/her poster for 1 minute in English/Hindi in the form of a Video (Poster should be visible in the video).**
- ◆ **Participants are requested to attach/ upload the photo of their poster in PDF format along with the Video (2 Separate files should be attached) at the time of filling the registration form for the competition.**
- ◆ Participants are requested to read the registration form carefully and fill appropriate details.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

- ◆ Relevance to the theme.
- ◆ Originality of the work submitted.
- ◆ Artistic composition and Creativity.
- ◆ Decision of jury will be considered final.

RESULTS:

- ◆ Best three posters will be selected and will be declared as the winners of the competition.
- ◆ The winners and participants will receive e-certificates.
- ◆ The results will be declared and certificates will be awarded to the participants within 15 days of the closure date of the competition.
- ◆ The results will be displayed on our College Library Website and Winners Names along with their posters will be published in the Library e-newsletter of December 2020 Issue.
